

## Education system being destroyed, says Khaleda

Begum Khaleda Zia on Sunday called for building up resistance against, what she said, conspiracy of the government to destroy the country's education system, reports UNB.

"This government has been deliberately trying to destroy the country's education system to suppress the conscience of the people," Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) Chairman said while addressing the newly elected members of the Dhaka City Unit of the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at the party central office.
