## Varsity officers to go on strike from June 11

Officers of eight universities will start a nonstop strike from June 11 to press their two demands, including revision of the downgraded pay-scale of 1977, reports UNB.

A meeting of Bangladesh Inter-university Officers' Federation held at the office of Dhaka University Officers Association on May 11 took the decision.

of Dhaka, Chittagong, Rajshahi, Jahangirnagar and Islamic Universities, Shahjalal University of Science and Technology, BUET and Bangladesh Agricultural University attended the meeting, a Press release said Friday.

The meeting expressed indignation at inaction of the Vice Chancellors Standing Committee of the University Council towards realising the two demands as per the discussion held with the Education Minister on April 24.

It requested the authorities to immediately fulfil the demands. The other demand is officers' representation in different university bodies, including Senate and Syndicate.

The meeting decided to keep open water, electricity and transport systems with minimum number of officers and medical service through call duty during the planned work stoppage.
