Ishwardi marks world's highest temperature

The world's highest temperature was recorded in Bangladesh on Friday with the mercury shooting upto 38.8 degrees celcius at northern town of Ishwardi, reports UNB.

The second highest temperature was recorded at 35 degrees at Holy Makkah and Bangkok, according to temperature chart of 83 cities of the world released by American news agency Associated Press (AP).

Ishwardi was followed by capital Dhaka where the temperature was registered at 38.7 degrees celcius.

Local weather experts said the temperature throughout the country is higher than usual during this time of the year.

They predicted that the current heat wave may continue for few more days and warned that the weather behaviour may cause severe nor'westers in many parts of the country.
