Teachers assure cooperation in polls process

Delegation of teachers representing different teachers associations and federations Tuesday met the Chief Election Commissioner Justice AKM Sadek at his office an Election Commission Press release said in Dhaka reports BSS.

The teachers, involved in the election duty, assured the Election Commission of extending all out support for holding the polls in a free, fair and smooth manner. At the same time, they urged the commission to ensure their personal security when they are on election duties.
