

Gunshots rock campus **DU teachers begin work abstention**

The teachers of Dhaka University began their work abstention for an indefinite period on Saturday following the failure of the government to take positive measure to curb terrorism on the campus.

The decision was taken in an emergency meeting of Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) on Friday.

Meanwhile the Dhaka University campus was shaken by several rounds of gun shots on Friday midnight.

The gun shots were heard from the direction of Surya Sen, Jasimuddin and Mohsin Hall area, according to the witnesses.

The witness also said a good number of armed elements took shelter in these residential halls.

The armed elements posted guard at the different gates of those halls at night.

The Masters Degree Examinees of Dhaka University submitted a memorandum to the Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah on Saturday demanding holding of their postponed examinations immediately.

A group of examinees met the
