

Firing at JCD leader condemned

Mr. Amanullah Aman MP, and convener of Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) on Thursday condemned firing at JCD leader Litu and acts of terrorism by whom he called "the armed hooligans of Mujibbadi Chhatra League", report BSS.

In a statement issued to the Press, he said it invites condemnation even to the Leader of the Opposition who, according to him, was patronising the killers in the Chhatra League to continue terrorism after suspending the activities of the organisation. As a result, he said 28 thousand students of the Dhaka University had been subjected to their acts of terrorism and even some of them had lost their lives.

Mr. Aman claimed that these Chhatra League workers had inflicted severe injuries on five JCD workers during the last week.

Giving an account of the extent of terrorism Mr. Aman cited specific incidents during last three days which

includes stabbing of S.M. Hall JCD leader Murad, firing at EUCSU General Secretary Fazlur Rahman, beating up of Mujib Hall JCD leader Kuddus. Firing at JCD leader Litu and later creating terrorism at the TSC area.

Expressing surprise over the publication of the name of JCD leader Elias in a section of press implicating him in terrorism in the campus on Thursday though he had been in Sylhet on an organisational tour for last three days, Mr. Aman said those newspapers were in fact trying to hide the 'real terrorists' and thus had exposed their "lack of sense of responsibility" by working in favour of the terrorists.

Mr. Aman said if Chhatra League did not stop such acts of terrorism immediately, the consequences would not bring any good. The JCD leaders and workers cannot continue to be beaten up at the hands of the Chhatra League workers, he asserted.

He said the conspiracy to stop examinations of the university by Chhatra League actions of terrorism could not be tolerated either.

The President and general secretary of Dhaka University branch of JCD also gave a similar statement.

In a separate statement, JCD convener Amanullah Aman, MP also condemned the firing and following actions of terrorism by what he said, the "flag-bearers of the fallen autocracy" at Suhrawardi college on Thursday and demanded immediate arrest of the miscreants.
