Students clash, Tongi college closed

At least ten students were injured, seven vehicles damaged and road communication at 13 places snapped at Dhaka-Mymensingh road following a clash between two rival student groups near the Tongi Government College on Saturday, reports BSS.

The clash ensued when Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal reportedly tried to resist a protest meeting of Bangladesh Chhatra League against the closure of the college for sine die.

Earlier, the authority had closed down the college sine die following a constitutional tangle over holding election of the students union, and harassment to the teachers by some students, the college authority sources said.

During the clash, several cocktails were exploded and two groups of the students used daggers, ram dao, chain and belt and other lethal weapons, according to eye-witness.

However, the local administration brought the situation under control.

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal Saturday filed a case with Tongi police.

Earlier the principal of the college also filed a case with regard to the prevailing situation of the college.
