

SSC students observe hartal in Cox's Bazar

COX'S BAZAR, Nov. 5:— A complete dawn to dusk hartal was observed in Cox's Bazar today at the call of SSC students in protest against the govt's new education policy and police attack on innocent students at Mirersarai.

The normal life came to a halt during hartal period. All shops, bazars, business establishment, educational institutions remained closed. All vehicles went off the roads except few rickshaws. The agitated students brought out several processions and paraded the roads of the town shouting slogans for withdrawal of double pass system in a subject.

They also demanded for resumption of SSC examination policy of 1992. The student organisations expressed their solidarity with the movement of SSC students and vehemently condemned police actions on students at Mirsarai. No untoward incident was reported.
