Principal assaulted in Feni

FENI, Aug. 24.— A group of youths today dragged the Principal of Dagonbhuiyan Iqbal Memorial College out of his office and locked it up, reports UNB.

Campus sources said about a dozen "terrorists" entered the compound at about 1 pm and put six office rooms of the college under lock and key.

The college reopened today after 17 days of closure following a clash between the supporters of Chhatra League (M-I) and Islami Chhatra Shibir on August 7.

Police were called in immediately after today's incident. The Principal could not identify the terrorists.

The office rooms remained locked as the college authorities apprehend further trouble. The governing body of the college will meet tomorrow at 10 a.m. to review the situation.
