Varsity teachers' sit-in strike in front of PM's office today

University teachers of the country will observe sit-in strike in front of Prime Minister's office on the concluding day of their three-day strike today (Tuesday) to demand arrest and trial of those involved in the recent incidents at Jahangirnagar and Islamic university.

The teachers of the country's seven universities went on strike on October 10 in response to the call of the Federation of Bangladesh University Teachers' Association (FBUTA), which also demands withdrawal of 'false' case filed by JUCSU V-P against ten teachers of Jahangirnagar University.

The Jahangirnagar University authorities have filed case against 21 JUCSU and JCD members for their alleged involvement in terrorism on the university campus on July 29.
