10 vehicles damaged in DU areas

At least 10 vehicles including the private car of a teacher of Dhaka University were damaged by a group of youths near the High Court and the Central Shaheed Minar on Friday night.

The activists of Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) brought out a protest procession on Friday evening from Dhaka University after receiving the news of killing of Ratan Sen in Khulna.

The processionists became violent and damaged a pajerojeep near High Court.

The processionists dispersed when police chased them. But they assembled again and went to the campus in a procession.

Later the processionists also damaged several vehicles in and around the campus by pelting stones.
