GCO holds rally against role of DU V-C

Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO), Dhaka University unit, on Saturday staged demonstration in front of Vice-chancellor's office in protest against his partisan role.

GCO, a platform of eight left leaning student bodies, accused V-C Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Mia of arranging the award giving ceremony last Thursday to please the BNP Government in which Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia was invited as chief guest.

Leaders and workers of GCO went to the V-C's office in a procession from Madhu's canteen and staged demonstration there for an hour.

GCO, DU unit leaders Khairul Islam, Rupom, Abu Bakkar Mustak, Alam Tolu and Aslam spoke at the gathering.

They bitterly criticised the Vice-Chancellor for not inviting them at the award giving ceremony and alleged that the V-C had arranged the function to achieve his interest.

They urged the Vice-Chancellor to maintain impartial role keeping in mind the glorious image of the University as well as the student community.

During the demonstration V-C Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Mia was absent from his office.
