Two DU halls raided, arms recovered

Police raided two residential halls of the University of Dhaka on Monday afternoon and recovered firearms and micro-telephone set from a toilet.

According to police, they conducted raid at Shahidullah, Fazlul Haque halls simultaneously and searched both the halls for about two hours and recovered revolver and micro-telephone set from a toilet of second floor of Shahidullah Hall.

None was arrested in this connection so far.

UNB adds, none was however, arrested in the raid on Shahidullah and Fazlul Huq halls, known as the strongholds of pro-government Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal.

Police and residents said a huge contingent of riot police along with plainclothes ones made the more than two-hour simultaneous operation till 6.15 p.m.

The law enforcing agencies with prior permission from the university authorities checked identity cards of the students and searched suspected nooks and corners of the dormitories in a hunt for weapons.

Hall authorities, including Pro-rectors and House Tutors, were present during the search.

ul Huq, Salimullah and Jagannath halls and recovered 2 cut-rifles, 61 bullets, 4 cocktails and three hand-telephone sets.

Earlier, police had raided several times Mohsin, Suryasen, Jashimuddin, Ziaur Rahman and Mujibur Rahman halls since the killing of two activists of JCD on September 4 in a factional feud.
