Tension in DU

BCL (M-I) leader held

Tension mounted at Dhaka University following the arrest of a leader of pro-Awami League Chhatra League (M-I) on Wednesday.

A group of agitated youths damaged three vehicles and opened several rounds of gunshot in the air creating panic among campus inmates.

Witnesses said, Detective Branch police in a special drive picked up Sahabuddin, a leader of Chhatra League (M-I), from TSC area on Wednesday noon. Sahabuddin was reportedly involved in three separate killing incidents, says a police Press release.

Immediately after the arrest of Sahabuddin, some youths fired three rounds of blank shots at TSC area and damaged two vehicles parked in front of TSC building. The agitated youths went to the Arts Building.
