Accord violation
JCD threatens strike on DU campus

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal on Wednesday threatened to reinforce strike in Dhaka University if the varsity authorities failed to resolve the recurring problems, reports UNB.

The threat came from a rally held in front of DUCSU Bhaban to protest an "aggressive" role of pro-Awami League Chhatra League in Suryasen Hall.

Addressing the rally, the JCD leaders alleged that BCL activists were trying to recapture the hall violating the 8-point agreement.

The agreement was signed by the university authorities and student bodies to resolve the deadlock in Suryasen Hall following the occupation of the dormitory by the BCL cadres.

JCD, the student wing of opposition BNP, called off their indefinite strike in the university as per the 8-point accord, said the student leaders.

After the agreement, activists of JCD and BCL are coexisting in the Suryasen Hall with continuous supervision by hall authorities and law-enforcing agencies.

But tension gripped the hall once again on Tuesday as the activists of JCD and BCL accused each other of disturbing their activists.

The trouble began when a room of the dormitory was damaged by some unidentified person. Both the organisations blamed each other for the incident, campus sources said.

The situation deteriorated further when an activists of BCL who is not a resident of Suryasen Hall tried to enter the dormitory.

Earlier, an activist of BCL allegedly misbehaved with a house tutor of the hall on Monday night when he asked him to produce his identity card while entering the hall.
