BCL calls strike
CU activities
disrupted
again

CHITTAGONG, May 11:—All the academic activities in Chittagong University were again disrupted today due to strike by Chhatra League.

The ruling Awami League-backed Chhatra League gave the indefinite strike call to protest, what they called, dastardly attack by Shibir activists on Chhatra League supporters at Campus Railway station during the reception of new students on May 5. The Chhatra League resumed the strike today after two-day suspension to facilitate the participation of freshers in the admission test.

The Chhatra League activists successfully enforced the strike by laying siege at the entrance of the campus at main road by turn throughout the day. As a result, no vehicle could ply to and from campus.

The campus-bound shuttle trains carrying students from the city did not ply today.

The inevitable was the suspension of classes of the students and other academic activities. The attendance of university employees was also thin.
