DUCSU leaders surprise at DU authorities statement

Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) VP Amanullah Aman, MP, General Secretary Khairul Kabir Khokon and Assistant General Secretary Nazimuddin Alam, MP, in a joint statement on Monday expressed surprise at the statement of the university on dissolution of DUCSU published in a section of dailies recently.

The DUCSU leaders said Vice-Chancellor Prof. A.K. Azad Chowdhury has not only made the highest post of the university controversial but also presented himself as a patroniser of the ruling party's politics by taking decision to dissolve the present DUCSU.

Condemning pro-Awami League Chhatra League the DUCSU leaders said that they were always interested to hold DUCSU polls as its term was over but BCL (S-P) was always against election and so the election was not held in due time although the university authorities announced election scheduled three times.

The leaders of the present DUCSU played an important role in the anti-autocracy movement in 1990, the DUCSU leaders said adding that now the present government was conspiring to dissolve DUCSU so that the DUCSU leaders could not launch any movement against the present government.

They demanded immediate reinstatement of the students who were ousted from Fazlul Haq Hall, Shahidullah Hall, Jagannath Hall, SM Hall, A.F. Rahman Hall, Zahurul Haq Hall and Mohsin Hall. They also demanded announcement of DUCSU polls date.

If the university authorities take step to dissolve the present DUCSU without fulfilling their demands then the authorities would be held responsible for the consequences, the DUCSU leaders said.
