JCD demands removal of police from campus

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) gheraoed the office of the Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University on Monday demanding removal of police from the campus, arrest of what they said the terrorists of the ruling party's student organisation and protesting the police harassment on the JCD activists.

They also submitted a memorandum to the Vice-Chancellor in support of their demands.

Earlier, the Chhatra Dal members brought out a procession on the university campus and went to the V-C's office with the procession. Police obstructed the processionists at the south gate of the administrative building of the university.

Later, the JCD members held a protest rally. JCD President Shahiduddin Chowdhury Ani, General Secretary Habib-un-Nabi Sohel, A.B.M. Mosharraf Hossain, Nasiruddin Washim and Selimuzzaman Selim, among others, addressed the rally.

Addressing the rally, the JCD leaders said that the police who are now on duty in the university was acting according to the directives of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL). They also said that the terrorists of the ruling party's student organisation was creating unrest on the campus through terrorist activities but police were not arresting them.

They also said that police arrested many JCD workers to stop the ongoing movement of JCD without any reason and resorting to repression on them.
