## JCD threatens to make DU inoperative

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal on Thursday threatened to make the Dhaka University inoperative if the "terrorists and outsiders" were not evicted from the campus soon, reports UNB.

The JCD leaders were addressing a sit-in programme in front of the Vice-Chancellor's office, demanding arrest of the terrorists and protesting police action on the party supporters at Ziaur Rahman Hall on Tuesday.

It was addressed, among others, by JCD President Shahiduddin Chowdhury Annie, General Secretary Habib-un-Nabi Sohel and leaders Monwar Hossain Rana, Shahabuddin Laltu, Monir Hossain, Mosharraf Hossain, Nasiruddin Osim and Manjur Elahi.

Annie accused the DU authorities of trying to rehabilitate the "terrorists and outsiders" of Awami League-backed Chhatra League in the University Halls.

"It's nothing, but a conspiracy to eradicate the JCD supporters from the campus," Annie said adding that the University authorities have become hostage in the hands of BCL terrorists.

Habib-un-Nabi said it would not be Chhatra for JCD to extend cooperation to the authorities if the campus was not made violence-free.
