6,527 HSC examinees expelled for cheating in Rajshahi Division

RAJSHAHI, Sept. 29.—A total of 6,527 examinees were expelled for adopting unfair means in the examination halls of Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examination for the year 1994, held in August last under the Rajshahi Education Board from 201 centres of 16 districts of the division, board sources said.

The district-wise break-up of expulsions is: Rajshahi-152; Natore-92; Chapainawabganj-135; Naogaon-178; Pabna-98; Sirajgonj-161; Bogra-175; Joypurhat-322; Rangpur-814;

Gaibandha-1632; Niphamari-512; Lalmonirhat-218; Kurigram-437; Dinajpur-568; Panchagarh-696 and Thakurgaon-337.

It may be mentioned here that 99,594 examinees including 29,402 girl students appeared in the HSC examinations this year under Rajshahi Education Board.

2 commit suicide

One Anjura Begum (18), wife of Sazzad Hossain of Mohanganj village under Baghmara thana commit-

ted suicide by taking poison on September 18.

The reason for committing suicide could not be known immediately.

One China (22), wife of Nasimuddin of Ramchandrapur village under Boalia thana committed suicide by taking insecticide on September 15.

Family feud may be reason for committing suicide.
