Lalmonirhat Govt College attacked following expulsion of HSC examinees

LALMONIRHAT, Aug. 4:—A group of angry people attacked the Lalmonirhat Government College and ransacked its Laboratory and principal's office protesting expulsion of six HSC examinees today (Thursday), reports UNB.

College sources said the rampaging people also roughed up two

Invigilators, including a female teacher, of the centre during the attack at 1 p.m.

The invigilators were identified as Raihana Binta Hossain of Borobari College and Amjad Hossain of Lalmonirhat College.

Later, the attackers stormed into the residence of the Principal Anwarul Islam and badly ransacked the house, witnesses said.

The principal alleged that the Magistrate on duty left the scene as the trouble erupted in the centre. A large number of answer-scripts were also missing, he added.

Meanwhile, Academic Council of the college called an emergency meeting in the evening to discuss the situation.
