## Rush of HSC examinees in mufassil colleges

**MANIKGANJ, Feb. 8:**—The rush of the HSC examinees has increased in the mufassil colleges of Manikganj district.

According to a source the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examinees from Dhaka city, Manikganj town, Savar and Dhamrai town have gone to Daulatpur Matilal College, Bachamara College, Taluknagar College, Mohadebpur Degree College, Kouri Degree College and Singair College to fillup forms for the ensuing HSC examination.

The examinees have gone to the Colleges in the rural areas with the motive of adopting unfair means in the examination halls. The rush of the examinees in the mufassil colleges has become acute because the authorities of the colleges provide facilities for the adoption of unfair means in the examination halls. They are realising excess amount of fees from the intending HSC examinees.

The opportunities for the adoption of unfair means in the HSC Examinations in Dhaka city, Manikganj

town, Savar and Dhamrai thana town are scarce. A section of HSC examinees are reluctant to appear at the examination in these town.

It is alleged that a section of dishonest college teachers received a huge amount of money from HSC examinees with a the guarantee of of success in the examination.

The authority of the Education Department took no steps to prevent the illegal activities of the dishonest teachers and examinees.

Meanwhile, the standard of education in Manikganj district has fallen due to the adoption of unfair means in the examinations. Good English teachers are not available in the district. The school, college and madarsha authorities of the district are facing serious problems in teaching the students of English language. Good teachers of other subjects are also not available in the district.

The declining trend of the standard of education is due to non-availability of good teachers.
