42.62 pc pass Jessore Board HSC exam

The results of the Higher Secondary (HSC) examinations of Jessore Education Board were announced on Sunday. A total of 39409 examinees out of 92470 came out successful in the examinations. The percentage of pass is 42.62.

Rubyet Adnan of Barisal Cadet College topped the merit list from science group securing 920 marks with letters in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Statistics. Mohammed Rajibul Huq and Ashiq Mohammad Tariq Masrur Khan, both from Jhenidah Cadet College got second and third position respectively, in the combined merit list.

Nasrin Sultana of Patuakhali Government College and Ishrat Jahan of Government Women College, Jessore shared the first position in the humanities group securing 865 marks. The second and the third position went to Mosammat Dilshad Surma of Shaheed Smriti College, Pirojpur and Mohammed Ishaque Ali of Kaliganj M.U. College, Jhenidah.

Mosammat Asma Jahan Khushi of Government B.M. College, Barisal stood first in the commerce group securing 820 marks. Mohammed Lutfur Rahman of Azam Khan Commerce College, Khulna and Sudipta Bose of Keshabpur College, Jessore secured second and third position respectively in the commerce group.

Afrin Sultana of Government B.M. College annexed the first position among the women securing 906 marks. She appeared from science group.

Of the total examinees from all the groups 7613 were placed in the first division, 26385 in second division and 5411 in the third division.

The percentage of pass in science group is 52.83, in humanities group 40.10 and in commerce 49.45.
