

SSC examinations results

38.86 pass in Rajshahi Board, 44.20 pass in Ctg Board

The results of Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations of Rajshahi and Chittagong Education Boards were announced on Thursday. The percentage of pass in Rajshahi Board is 38.86 and in Chittagong Board is 44.20.

Earlier, the results of SSC Exams held under Dhaka, Jessore and Comilla Education Boards were announced. The percentage of pass in Dhaka Board was 42.20, in Jessore Board 43.99 and in Comilla board 47.02.

A total of 1,26,234 students appeared in the examination under Rajshahi Education Board of whom 49,050 came out successful. Of them, 20,416 got first division, 27,961 second division and 673 third division.

The groupwise percentage of pass is 65.37 in science group and 27.55 in social science (humanities) group.

A total of 37,735 candidates appeared in the science group of whom 24,669 came out successful. Of the successful candidates, 15,562 got first division, 9,069 second division and 38 third division.

From social science (humanities) group, a total of 88,499 students appeared in the examination of whom 24,381 passed. Of the successful students, 4,854 got first division, 18,892 second division and 635 third division.

Abinash Roy of Bogra Zila School stood first in the combined merit list

of science group securing 940 marks with distinction in seven subjects.

Sheela Sarker of Government PN Girls' School stood first in the combined merit list of social science (humanities) group securing 877 marks with distinction in six subjects.

A total of 19,545 students out of 44,218 appeared in the SSC examinations under Chittagong Board came out successful. Of the total successful candidates, 8,413 got first division, 10,577 second division and 555 third division.

The groupwise percentage of pass

under Chittagong Board is 61.76 in science group and 32.28 in social science (humanities) group.

A total of 17,883 candidates appeared from the science group of whom 11,044 came out successful. Of the successful students 6,920 got first division, 4,110 second division and 14 third division.

From the social science (humanities) group, a total of 26,335 appeared in the examination of whom 8,501 passed. Of the successful students, 1,493 got first division,

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6,467 second division and 541 third division.

Abu Zafar Mohammed Dayemullah of Fauzdarhat Cadet College stood first in the combined merit list, securing 917 marks with distinction in eight letters.

Aashna Yasmin Rahman of Ispahani Public High School GPO in Chittagong topped the combined merit list of social science (humanities) group, securing 891 marks with distinction in six subjects.
