

Admission in Cadet Colleges- 1981 Intake

1. Applications for admission to Class VII in all the six Cadet Colleges in prescribed forms, obtainable from the Colleges concerned are invited from the intending candidates so as to reach the Colleges concerned latest by 15 January 1981.

2. Eligibility.

- Admission is open to boys only. Candidates who have already taken admission test/interview twice are not eligible to apply.
- Qualification. — Candidates must have passed Class VI.
- Age. — Not above 12½ years and not below 11 years on 1st Jan. 1981.
- Physical. — Should be physically fit.
- Height. — Minimum: 4'—4" Maximum: 5'—0"
- Nationality. — Candidates must be Bangladeshi by birth or domicile.

3. A candidate seeking admission may indicate name of one more Cadet College other than the one he is applying for.

4. Application forms and detailed information for admission to the Cadet Colleges along with a prospectus of the College will be available on submission of a self-addressed envelope (9"x6" size) with Taka 3/50 postal stamp and a postal order for Taka 15/- (Taka Fifteen) only in favour of Principal of respective Cadet Colleges under the following adderss:—

- Tests: Candidates will be required to sit for written tests in Bengali, English and Mathematics each carrying 100 marks and 90 minutes duration on 15 February 1981 at any of the following centres convenient to them: Barisal Bogra Comilla, Dacca, Dinajpur, Faridpur, Jessore Khulna Kushtia, Mymensingh, Pabna, Rajshahi Rangamati, Faujdarhat Cadet College, Jhenidah Cadet College, Momenshahi Cadet College, Rajshahi Cadet College, Rangpur Cadet College (Rangpur) and Sylhet Cadet College.
- Interview and Medical Tests: Candidates who qualify in the written test will be called for Interview and Medical Tests.
- Candidates who qualify in the written tests and interview will be medically examined to determine physical fitness and those found fit will be eligible for admission to the Cadet Colleges. The decision of the Medical Board will be final and no appeal will be entertained. Admission will be made strictly according to merit and the income of the parents/guardians will have no bearing for admission in the Cadet Colleges. However, the fees that would have to be paid to the College by the parents/guardians will depend entirely on the total income of the parents/guardians of the candidate.

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
