Subject:—COMMONWEALTH SC HOLARSHIPS FOR 1982—83.

Applications are invited from bonafide citizens of Bangladesh for selection of candidates for Commonwealth Scholarships tenable in U.K., Canada, etc. for higher studies at Post-graduate/Research level in the subjects mentioned below from the academic year 1982.

2. The minimum qualifications to apply for these scholarships for Arts and Science subjects is a Master's degree with Hons and for Engineering and Medical subjects a Bachelor's degree. The candidates who fulfil the minimum academic qualifications mentioned against the subjects below and other conditions should only apply :—

(i) Economics, Public Administration, Business Administration, Educational Planning, English Literature, Geography. Master's degree with first class either in Hons or Master's degree and a First Division either in SSC or HSC examination with Second Class/Division in the remaining examinations. Candidates who wish to undertake Post-graduate study in Business Administration/ Business Management should have taken G.M.A.T. & should have secured satisfactory scores.

(ii) Physics, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Zoology, Botany, Geology, Pharmacy, Genetics & Plant Breeding, Horticulture, Fisheries, Animal Husbandry, Veterinary Science. Master's degree with first class in Hons & Master's degree examinations & at least one first and one Second Division in SSC or HSC examination.

(iii) Civil, Electrical, Mechanical, Chemical Engineering & Architecture, Textile Technology. Ist Class B.Sc. (Engg)/B.Sc. (Architecture)/B. Sc. Textile Technology degree with Ist Divisions in SSC & HSC examinations.

(iv) Urban & Regional Planning. Master's degree in Urban and Regional Planning with Ist Class B.Sc. (Civil) Engineering and Ist/2nd Division in SSC and HSC examinations.

(v) Medicine, Surgery, Radiology, Gynaecology, Paediatrics, Dentistry, Ophthalmology. M.B.B.S. degree (regular) with First Divisions in SSC & HSC examinations. Candidates should possess qualifications registrable with General Medical Council in U.K. Medical graduates who passed M.B.B.S. between 7 Feb

22/1958 & 23 May 1972 from Dacca Medical College are only eligible for this registration.

3. Scholarships in Medical subjects are available in U.K. only. Medical candidates who are interested for doing M.R.C.P, F.R.C.S. etc. should be given preference if they have already completed first part of such examination.

4. Candidates should not be over 35 years of age on 1st October, 1982. Applicants already holding a Doctorate degree are not eligible.

5. Persons in service must apply through proper channel. Candidates who availed of foreign scholarship and received academic degrees from abroad but have not completed a minimum period of 5 years service/stay in Bangladesh on return from abroad, are also not eligible.

6. Applications on plain paper giving the following particulars together with attested copies of certificates diplomas, degrees, mark-sheets, testimonials, etc. should reach the undersigned by 30th September 1981 at the latest. Applicants may also drop their applications in the wooden box kept in the Reception Room, 2nd Gate, Bangladesh Secretariat, Dacca. Incomplete applications and those received after the last date will automatically stand rejected.
