First Class Bachelor's Degree Engineering/Architecture with at least second divisions in SSC & HSC examination. No third class division at any stage.

First Class Bachelor's Degree preferably with Honours and at least second divisions in SSC & HSC. examinations. Divisions is relaxable in the case of Fine Arts candidates. No third division/class at any stage.

FOR RESEARCH/PH. D. DEGREE

Statistics, Physics, Chemistry, Geology, Pharmacy.

First class both in Hons. and Master's Degree with at least 2nd division in SSC & HSC examination. No third division/class at any stage.

Chemical, Civil, Electrical, Mechanical and Petroleum Engineering.

First class M. Sc. Degree in Engineering with 2nd class division in the remaining examinations. No third division class at any stage.

Plant Breeding, Animal Husbandry, Veterinary Science and Fisheries.

First class Master's Degree with at least second class division in the remaining examinations. No third division/class at any stage.

Economics, Sociology, History, Comparative Literature, Bengali Literature, Educational Planning, Accounting/Management, Linguistics, Pa'i, Sanskrit, Journalism and Law.

Master's Degree and Honours Degree with First class either in Master's or Honours. At least second class division in the remaining examinations. No third division/class at any stage.
