Applications are invited from bona fide citizens of Bangladesh for East-West Center's (Hawaii) 1985-86 degree Study Awards. These study grants are offered to highly promising foreign nationals from Asian and Pacific countries on competitive basis and for Master's and Ph. D. degree in a wide variety of disciplines at the various institutes of the University of Hawaii.

2. The candidates who fulfil the following conditions should only apply:—

(a) Subject	Educational Qualifications
(a) Engineering Sub-Subjects	First Division class with 65% marks from SSC to B.Sc (Engineering Examinations).
(b) Humanities and Social Sciences Hons. & Master's degree including American Literature (not less than 58% marks) with at least and American History	Upper 2nd Class both in Social Sciences Hons. & Master's degree (not less than 58% marks) with at least first Division in SSC & HSC Examinations.
(c) Science Subjects including Agriculture	First Class both in Hons. & Master's Degree with 65% marks and first Division in SSC & HSC (In the event either the Bachelor's or the Master's is below 58% for Humanities and Social Sciences and 65% for Science, the applicant must secure 65% marks in the Intermediate).

2. Be not over 35 years of age.
3. Not have studied in the USA previously.
4. Be in Bangladesh at the time of Selection.
5. Be very good in English.
6. Be in good health.
7. Return to Bangladesh on completion of studies in Hawaii.
8. Preference will be given to those who already taken Test of English As a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and either Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) and scored minimum 550 in TOEFL and 1200 and 500 in GRE and GMAT respectively.

3. The Study Grant includes round-trip Economy Class air fare (b) a monthly maintenance stipend of US \$360— (c) free housing at East-West Centre dormitory or a housing allowance of \$ 230 p.m. plus free tuition fee, book allowance and health and accident insurance.

4. Persons already in service must apply through proper channel.

5. Incomplete applications received after 10th July, 1984 will be rejected without assigning any reasons.
