### ADMISSION TO THE PRELIMINARY MASTER'S DEGREE COURSES FOR THE SESSION 1983-84

Applications on plain paper are invited for admission to the Master's Degree (Preliminary) courses of the University of Dhaka for the Session 1983-84. The applications will be received by the Chairman of the department concerned from 10th June to 25th June, 1984 at the latest.

Only those who have passed the degree examinations of 1981-1982 and 1983 and have secured at least Second Division in any two of the three examinations from S.S.C. to degree and have obtained at the degree examination at least 40% marks in the subject they want to study in the Master's degree class or in an approved allied subject are eligible to apply.

Besides, only those who have appeared at the 1982 Honours examination and obtained pass degree and have secured at least second division in both S.S.C & H.S.C or First division either in S.S.C or H.S.C are also eligible to apply. But they will have to appear at the written test to be conducted by the department concerned.

Applications for admission to the Preliminary M.A. class in Linguistics will be received by the Chairman, Department of Bengali, Dhaka University.

Applications for admission to the Preliminary M.S.S. class in Social Welfare will be received by the Director Institute of Social Welfare & Research.

Candidates seeking admission to the Preliminary M.A. course in Mass Communication & Journalism must have 40% marks either in Bengali or English at the degree level and those who have not studied English or Bengali at the degree level must have 50% marks either in Bengali or English at the H.S.C level.

Each department will conduct a written admission test of 100 marks. Minimum pass marks will be 30. No candidates will be selected for admission unless he secured a minimum of 30 marks.

Selection will be made on the basis of the marks obtained in the S.S.C., H.S.C & Degree examinations or of any equivalent examination/examinations and performance of the candidates in the written admission test.

Each candidate will have to pay to the Chairman of the department concerned a sum of Tk. 15 (fifteen) as fee for admission test.

The application must contain the following information & documents :-

- (a) Name of the candidate
- (b) Father's name
- (c) Permanent address
- (d) Present address
- (e) Name of the department to which admission is sought.
- (f) Year and divisions of passing the S.S.C, H.S.C. and degree examinations.
- (g) Marks obtained at the degree examination in the subject/allied subject concerned.
- (h) Attested copies of mark certificates of S.S.C, H.S.C. & degree examinations issued by the Board/University concerned. Mark certificates by the Schools and Colleges
