A candidate with Bachelor or its equivalent degree in any field of study with at least 6 (six) points calculated on the following basis may apply for admission test. Candidate having two third divisions is not eligible to apply.

Candidates awaiting Bachelor degree examination results expected to be published by January 1986 may apply for taking the Admission Test provided they have at least 4 (four) points calculated on the above basis.

Application form, a copy of prospectus and a sample admission test booklet may be obtained from the Institute's office (Room No. 105A) on depositing of Tk. 10 (Ten) to C.D. Account No. 2545 in Janata Bank, Dhaka University TSC Branch in favour of "IBA Admission" or by mail sending the above amount in Bank Draft/Pay Order and a self-addressed envelope (size 9"x6") with postage stamp of Tk. 9 (nine) only to the Admission Office (Room 105A), IBA, University of Dhaka.

Duly filled in application form must reach the IBA Office on or before January 21, 1986. Candidates should deposit Tk. 30 (Thirty) to the Janata Bank account mentioned above and present the counterfoil along with the application form to the IBA Office for obtaining Admit Card for the Admission Test. Those who would like to send the application form by mail should enclose the Bank Draft/Pay Order and the form must reach the office within the specified date.
