Secretary, Bangladesh Public Service Commission Secretariat,
invites applications for the following posts :—

27. **BPSCS-C/A-1/95** :— 102 (One hundred two)
permanent posts of 'Thana Education Officer' for the
Primary Education Department under the Primary and
Mass Education Division.

PAY :— Taka 2850—125—3725—EB—130—5155/- plus
other benefits/allowances as admissible under the
rules.

QUALIFICATION :— Second Class Master's degree with a
Second Class Bachelor's degree from a recognised
University.

AGE : Not exceeding 30 years on 1st April, 1995, relaxable
up to 45 years for the teachers of Government
Primary Schools and Assistant Thana Education
Officers.

Women candidates are also eligible to apply for the
post.

Closing date : 17th May, 1995/3rd Joistha, 1402.

GENERAL IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS

- Upper age limits are also relaxable for freedom fighter candidates upto 32 years for the post for which the maximum age is less than 32 years. A released/retired Non-Commissioned armed forces personnel will get the benefit of age relaxation for Government jobs upto a maximum period the person has actually served the armed forces subject to condition that a released/retired Non-Commissioned Armed Forces personnel who has attained the age of superannuation will not be eligible for recruitment to Civil posts.
- Ad-hoc appointees (is any) against the posts will be eligible to apply only if at the time of entry into services as ad-hoc appointees they were within the prescribed age limits and had the requisite qualification according to recruitment rules.
- Ad-hoc appointees against the posts mentioned in the advertisement and persons already in Government Service or in the service of a local authority should submit their original applications together with Treasury Chalan or Bank Draft/Pay Order and necessary certificates direct to the specified office of the Commission's Secretariat so as to reach on or before the closing date mentioned in the advertisement. Another copy should be simultaneously submitted through the Department.
- Domicile** : A citizen and permanent resident of Bangladesh or domiciled therein (vide instructions in the application form).
- Selection of candidates will be made as per existing Government Orders regarding reservation of quotas for merit and for freedom fighter and women candidates, etc.

6. **Fees** : Each application must be accompanied with a Treasury Chalan under the Head "65-Miscellaneous Non-Tax Revenue", "Miscellaneous Examination Fee" or a Bank Draft/Pay Order from Sonali Bank in favour of "the Secretary, Bangladesh Public Service Commission Secretariat" for Tk. 25/- (vide instructions in the application form).

7. Application form can be obtained on payment of Tk. 5/- from the office of —

8. Application forms will be received only at the office of the Commission Secretariat situated at Old Airport Building, Tejgaon, Dhaka-1215.

No application will be entertained unless it is in the prescribed printed form of the Bangladesh Public Service Commission Secretariat and is received during office hours on or before the closing date either by post or by hand.

9. Candidates must submit attested copies of the following certificates along with their applications without which their candidature will not be considered :—

- For proof of age** : Original certificate of S.S.C./Matriculation/Equivalent Examination. Provisional Certificate or Admit card or Testimonial will not be accepted for this purpose.
- For proof of educational qualification** : Original Certificate issued by the Board or University. In case the Board or University fails to issue the original Certificate, Provisional Certificate issued by the Board or University may be accepted. For proof of educational qualification Marksheets issued by the University may also be accepted on condition that the Original/ Provisional certificates shall have to be submitted before interview.
- In the case of Freedom Fighters** : Certificate signed by the Chairman, Bangladesh Muktiyoddha Sangsad and countersigned by the Chief Adviser of the Bangladesh Muktiyoddha Sangsad the Hon'ble President of Bangladesh.
- In the case of Tribal** : Certificate issued by the appropriate authority.

10. Applications which are not supported by attested copies of Certificates of Board/ University/Institute and other documentary evidence regarding age, Educational qualification, Experience, etc. will not be entertained.

11. Canvassing in any form will disqualify a candidate.

12. The Commission will consider all applications received and interview the eligible candidates after holding scrutiny examination, if necessary.

13. Interview of candidates will be held at Dhaka only.
