1. No candidate can apply for more than one subject selection will be made after adding the mark obtained in SSC & HSC.
2. If any body is selected for scholarship for a country then generally he will not be considered for scholarship of other country. So the persons who are not really interested for this scholarship are advised keep abstain to apply.
3. Two copies of application in plain paper in English according to the following chart will have to be submitted. Attested photo copies of certificates and marksheets of passing both the examinations of candidates any copy of recent passport size photo duly attested will have to submitted with an application. Copy of other application will have to be enclosed with original application by the alpin or gems clip in such away the same can be easily separated. No need of submit other any application.

4. Application should reach the address of the undersigned in the wooden box kept at gate No. 5 of Bangladesh Secretariat by 31.1.99. But the candidates are advised to submit application as early as possible before the above last date. Incomplete application will be treated as canceled. Indian scholarship, name of subject, total marks obtained in SSC & HSC examinations will have to be written distinctly on the envelope containing application.

5. List of preliminary selected candidates for nomination will be displayed in the Ministry of Education and National Academy of Education Management (NAEM) on 15.2.99. No letter will be sent to candidates. Selcted candidates will have to submit forms immediately on collecting the same from the office of the Registrar of NAEM. Original certificate, mark sheets will have to be submitted at the time of submission of form. In order to submit immediately, 6 copies of certificate, copies certificate & Marksheet, Syllabus in English and other documents as required should be kept ready. If the information or description submitted by the candidate are found false after verification by the concerned education board legal action will be takes.

7. The decision of the government of Bangladesh will be treated as final in respect of selection of candidate.

8. The government of Bangladesh will not bear any responsibility except the scholarship offered by the government of India.
