

Life-sketch of Abdul Haque

The only son of late Alhaj Md. Wazed Ali Mr. Muhammad Abdul Haque, was born on November 15, 1926 at Ula-shi in the district of Nadia. In 1942 he passed the Matriculation examination with a Government Scholarship passed B.Sc. and L.L.B. examinations with distinction. He joined the Kushtia Bar in 1952.

In 1952, he organised the Language Movement in Kushtia and became Chairman of Kushtia District All Party State Language Committee of Action.

In 1966 he left for UK for higher studies in Law and was called to the Bar. In 1957, he joined the Seventh World Youth Festival held at Moscow and visited many European countries.

In 1960 he joined the Dacca High Court. In 1962 he was elected to the National Assembly of the then Pakistan as an Independent candidate and later became leader of the NAP Parliamentary Party. He was also the Whip of the Opposition people's Group in the Assembly. On his adjournment motion relating to cement crisis in the then East Pakistan the Government was defeated in the Assembly.
