

Girls' cadet college in Faridpur soon

A new girls' cadet college will be set up near Faridpur town at an estimated cost of Taka 24.33 crore.

Work on the construction of the college starts from July 5, 1990 on the land near town which was earlier acquired for building a cantonment.

Ministry of Defence has already approved the project which is aimed at meeting long felt demand of the people of Faridpur to set up a cadet

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college in the district. The construction of the said college is expected to be completed during the Fourth Plan period.

The Construction of the Bangladesh National Cadet Corps (BNCC) headquarters and regimental headquarters will also be taken up next year at an estimated cost of Taka 2.5 crore in Dhaka.

Under the same Ministry establishment of two seismic observatories is also envisaged during the Fourth Plan period.

Muktijoddha Kalyan Trust under the Ministry of Defence is considering a proposal to construct new glass factory at an approximate cost of Taka five crore.

The construction may start next year if the project is included in ADP of next year. Other schemes include an agro-based project which envisages extensive cultivation of pine-apple and oranges in Chittagong Hill Tracts and an amount of Taka 50 lakh is expected to be spent for this project.
