## Admission rush in schools at Naogaon

NAOGAON, Feb. 1:—To ease the unusual rush of admission seekers in the govt. school, the local K.D. Govt. High School started a new section in Class III this year enabling 30 more students to get admission. In all 61 students have been admitted out of 317.

The other Govt. High School for boys, Naogaon Zilla School, cannot start new sections due to shortage of staff and incompleteness of the under-construction rooms.

The post of the Head Master, Assistant Head Master and Assistant teacher has been lying vacant in the school for a long time.

At least 30 students were deprived of admission in Class III of the

school.

With the relaxation of stringent conditions in respect of quality and specification about the food grains to be procured the situation has considerably improved.

The target of aman procurement has been fixed at 6118 tons of paddy and 2423 tons of rice. The govt started procurement at 11 procurement centres.

Beginning from January 1 so far 600 tons of paddy and 271 tons of rice have been procured.

The prevailing price of paddy is Tk.175 and rice is Taka 330 as against the govt. rate of Tk.210 for paddy and Tk.323.40 paisa for rice per maund.
