52,000 applications for 3,775 DU Hons seats

Some 14 applicants are likely to vie for each seat in the test for admission into First Year Honours Classes of Dhaka University this year.

A total of 52 thousand applications have been received against 3775 seats till Saturday, the last day of submitting application.

Some university officials while talking to the Bangladesh Observer on Saturday said that this year the highest number of applicants would complete for admission into the University, since its establishment.

A total of 15,400 students submitted their applications for 995 seats of 15 departments under Science and Biological Science faculties covering "Ka" unit.

The number of applications, received under the "Kha" unit for 1700 seats of 17 Department of Arts, Social Science and Law Faculties are 12,600.

The Commerce Faculty received 7900 applications for its 580 seats of four departments under the "Ga" unit while the largest number of applications have been submitted for the combined unit "Gha". The number is 16,100.

The applicants of "Gha" unit will face toughest competition for each seat. The ratio of seat and application under this unit is 1:32 which is followed by "Ka" unit—1:15 "Ga" unit 1:14 and "Kha" unit 1:7.

Some admission seekers who came to submit their application on Saturday

day were interviewed by this correspondent.

Feroza Shahin who applied for the departments under "Ka" unit said that she had to take special coaching for the last three months for the admission test.

She bought four admission guides as a part of her admission preparation. "I don't know wheather I would get the chance to be a DU student or not but it is my dream to be a student of the Oxford of the East".

The test examinations for "Ka" unit will be held on February 4 while for "Kha" unit on January 28. "Ga" Unit January 29 and "Gha" unit January 21.
