



Dr Sharif made BOU Pro-VC

A specialist in electronics and computer communications Dr RI Sharif has been appointed Pro-Vice Chancellor of Bangladesh Open University, says a Press release.

Prior to his appointment as Pro-Vice Chancellor Dr Sharif was Professor in the Department of Physics and Electronics of Dhaka University. He obtained PhD degree on Electronics from Durham University in 1977. From 1983 to 1985 he worked as a faculty member and research fellow of the computer controlled mobile telecommunication project under electronics and electrical division of the Leeds University in USA. Professor Sharif also worked on electronics and communications under Royal Military College of England and Strathclyde University. He is associated with a number of computer and electronics institutes both at home and abroad.

Professor Sharif attended many of international seminars, workshops and conferences on computer applications and rural telecommunications in India, Pakistan, UK, USA and Italy. He was a proposer for the Nobel prize in Physics for the year 1994.

A former Vice-President of Bangladesh Computer Society, Dr Sharif has to his credit 25 research publications in national and international journals.

He was born at Banaripara in Barisal district in 1944.
