

CU students observe strike

CHITTAGONG, Nov 22.—The students in Chittagong University today abstained from attending their classes at the call of the All-Party Student Unity (APSU).

Earlier, five activists namely Abdul Hamid, Nowab Hossain, Nizam Uddin, Khalilur Rahman and Mamunur Washid were injured when procession of the Islami Chhatra Shibir was attacked reportedly by armed opponents after the Islami Chhatra Shibir held rallies and brought out processions on the campus to protest the attack on Shibir meeting. The Shibir termed the attack as a conspiratorial move to drive wedge in the unity of students community for democratic movement.

The Islami Chhatra Shibir today laid siege of university building and staged sit in demonstration in front of Vice-Chancellor Office. The Vice-Chancellor Prof Alamgir Mohammad Shirajuddin however, did not attend his office today.

The GU-CSU Vice-President Mohammed Nazimuddin in press conference on Wednesday blamed the Islami Chhatra Shibir of unabated terrorism on the campus for past three days.

However, the All-Party Student Unity and Islami Chhatra Shibir brought out processions today in support of its respective issues.
