

CU teachers critical of VC's role

CHITTAGONG, Dec. 14 :—The Chittagong University Teachers Association (CUTA) criticized the incumbent Vice-Chancellor for what they called his "double standard". In a joint statement to the Press the CUTA President, Professor Yusuf Sharif Ahmed Khan and General Secretary Dr. Abul Kalam Azad said that the Chittagong University Vice-Chancellor launched tirade publicity for vilification of the glorious role of University teachers during the mass movement against Ershad government.

CUTA leaders lashed at the Vice-Chancellor Professor Alamgir Mohammad Shirajuddin calling his move as "heinous attempt" to suppress his anti-people activities during the mass movement. The CUTA President and General Secretary claimed that the Vice-Chancellor uncannily turned down the proposition for stepping down and declined to attend Gayebi Janaja for those martyrs who laid down their lives during the mass movement.
