CU teachers want VC's resignation

CHITTAGONG, Dec. 18: Chittagong University Teachers' Association (CUTA) today demanded a judicial inquiry into the alleged wrongdoings of the Vice-Chancellor in running the university, reports BSS.

Addressing a Press conference at the local Press Club this afternoon CUTA President Mr. Yusuf Sharif Ahmad Khan pointed that the University administration had been crippled because of alleged unfair activities of the Vice-Chancellor.

The CUTA President listed nepotism, stoppage of due promotions of teachers and financial irregularities as alleged corruptions of the Vice-Chancellor.

CUTA also demanded the resignation of the Vice-Chancellor.
