Election of CUTA demanded

CHITTAGONG, Dec. 30 — One hundred 20 teachers of Chittagong University today demanded election of Chittagong University Teachers Association (CUTA) Executive Committee will in the next 15 days, calling the present activities of the CUTA as illegal, reports BSS.

The teachers who held a meeting at the University Arts Faculty gallery with Dr. Fashiul Alam, a member of the executive committee of CUTA resented CUTA Executive Committee's silence over an earlier call for a requisitioned meeting of the committee.

The meeting decided that if the election of the executive committee was not held within 15 days, a new committee will be constituted at a general meeting of the university teachers.

The meeting expressed condolence on the death of Farooquzzaman Farooq, a second year student of statistics, and demanded exemplary punishment to those responsible for December 22 incident on the campus.

It termed the demand for resignation of the Vice-Chancellor as unconstitutional, conspiratorial and motivated.

The meeting called upon the people not to be misled by motivated statements of any vested group on the university incident. They also urged the Bangladesh University Teachers Federation leaders not to cooperate with the secretary general of the federation who is also general secretary of CUTA.
