### UNESCO Club, Federation council meet held

The two-day long 5th general Council of the National Federation of UNESCO Clubs in Bangladesh was held in Dhaka on December 24 and 25, says a press release.

Councillors from different UNESCO clubs took part, which was presided over by Mr. Muhammad Reazur Rahman, President, NFUCB.

The Council unanimously amended the constitution re-naming the Federation as National Federation UNESCO Clubs and Associations in Bangladesh. A new National Executive Committee was elected with Muhammad Rezur Rahman as President, Al Mamun Titu as Vice President, S.M. Rahman as Secretary General and Syed M. Afzaluddin as Treasurer.

### UNESCO team calls on Zillur Rahman

A delegation of UNESCO led by director, principal regional office for Asia and Pacific of UNESCO, Bangkok, Mr. Hedayet Ahmed Saturday called on Education Adviser Professor Zillur Rahman Siddiqui at the latter's office in Dhaka on Saturday, reports BSS.

They discussed matters of common interests with particular reference to proposed UNESCO technical assistance of seven million dollars under general education project of the Ministry of Education and activities of UNESCO in Bangladesh. The question of extending UNESCO cooperation in education, science and technology and cultural sector of the country also came up for discussion.

The 4th sub-regional training workshop for literacy personnel to be held in Dhaka from January 2 to 16, 1991 under sponsorship of UNESCO and mass education project (MEP) also figured in the discussion. About 30 representatives from seven countries of this region will participate in the workshop, the adviser was informed. Education Adviser will formally inaugurate the workshop.

The Education Secretary A.N.M. Eusuf, UNESCO expert Dr. Selim and Secretary of UNESCO Commission in Bangladesh Mr. Abdus Salim were present.
