

65.43 p.c. pass Jessore Board SSC exams

JESSORE, June 28.—The results of the Secondary School Certificat (SSC) Examination of the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education Jessore held in 1978 were announced today. Twenty-six thousand nine hundred and eighty-three students passed the examinations out of a total of 41,237, the percentage of pass being 65.43.

The groupwise percentage of pass: Humanities—58.9; Science—85.10; Commerce—71.11; Agriculture—77.59; Industrial Arts—79.36 and Home Economics—81.68.

In the combined list 2,068 students were placed in the First Division, 9,644 in the Second Division and 15,371 in the Third Division.

A total of 25,039 candidates appeared in the Humanities Group and 14,547 came out successful. One hundred and thirty-eight students passed in the First Division, 3,921 in the Second Division and 10,488 in the Third Division. The percentage of pass in the Humanities group is 58.09.

Seven thousand six hundred and twenty-eight candidates passed in the Science group out of a total of 8,963. One thousand six hundred and ninety-six candidates have been placed in the First Division, 3,710 in the Second Division and 2,222 in the Third Division. The percentage of pass in the Science group is 85.10.

A total of 3,507 students appeared in the Commerce group of which 2,498 came out successful. The percentage of pass is 71.11. Sixty students passed in the First Division while 925 in the Second Division and 1,509 in the Third Division.
