

NGO men, madrasa students clash in B'baria: 100 hurt

BRAHMANBARIA, Dec 7.—About one hundred people were injured 25 of them seriously following a clash between NGO people, police and local madrasa students at Neaz Mohammad High School ground this afternoon. Seriously injured 25 persons were admitted to Brahmanbaria Sadar Hospital.

NGO people led by Dr. Kazi Farooq Chairman ADAB brought out a procession in the town and took an attempt to hold a rally at Neaz Mohammad stadium. Madrasa students backed by local people also brought out a procession and attack-

ed the rally of NGOs and finally disrupted it.

On duty police immediately took necessary measures and brought the situation under control after firing 50 rounds of rubber bullets and lobbing 40 rounds of teargas shells.

No case was registered in this connection and nobody was taken into the custody.

Madrasa students and local people again brought out a procession in the evening and declared dawn-to-dusk hartal in Brahmanbaria town tomorrow (Tuesday).
