## Madrasa upgraded at Ramganj

RAMGANJ, Apr 10:— Champuri Shaha Ashrafia Sunni Madrasa at west Angorpara, Ramganj, Luxmipur, has been formally elevated to the status of Ibte Dayite, and inaugurated by Gadinashin-Peerjada Al-Haj Syed Maulana Mohammad Abu Ashraf Gaziul Huq Chandpuri Shah, on February 10, according to a press release.

First started as a Farkania Madrasa way back in the sixties, it was later elevated to Hefz before assuming its current upgradation as an Ibte-Dayite Madrasa, to the long cherished aspirations of the local people.
