Nationalisation of non-govt priy schools demanded

BOGRA, Jan 28:—A meeting of Bogra District Non-Government Primary School Teachers Samity demanded nationalisation of all registered non-government primary schools and regularisation of service of the teachers working in these schools in a meeting held in the local Woodburn Public Library on January 20 last with Mr. Md. Shamsul Alam, President, incharge of the central committee in the chair.

The meeting was attended by Alhaj Akkas Ali Sheikh, Secretary General of the Central Committee, as the chief guest Mr Mriden Mohon Saha, Office-Secretary.

Extending his all-out support to the demands of the teachers, Mr Golam Rabbani, Amir, Bogra District Unit of Jamat-e-Islami Bangladesh, spoke in the meeting.

Having taken a decision of creating mass opinion against the ruling government party and its failure in meeting the demand of 92 thousand working teachers of 23 thousand registered non-government primary

schools in the country in respective areas and the speakers criticised the govt. Among others, Mr Bazlur Rahman, Vice-President, Shahjahan Ali, General Secretary, District Unit of the Samity Mukbul Hossain of Dhunat, Abdul Jalil Harun-or-Rashid Bablu, Khorshed Alam, Abu Zafar, Abu Horira, Ashraful Islam of Sontola and Nurul Amin and Sabdur Rahman of Gabtali spoke in the meeting.

The teachers brought out a procession and submitted a memorandum

to the Deputy Commission. They also gheraoed the DC's office.
