



One primary school in each village to be established

The present government will take all possible measures to eradicate illiteracy to ensure quality education for all and establish one primary school in each village in next ten years, report UNB.

This was stated by Education, Primary and Mass Education and Science and Technology Minister ASHK Sadique when the visiting Deputy Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund (IMF), PR Narayan, called on him at his secretariat office on Saturday.

During the discussion, the Minister apprised the IMF dignitary of the infrastructural and other problems faced by the education system of the country.

He said the government had started the process of introducing an effective and well-arranged national education policy. Necessary steps have already been initiated to find out

irregularities and drawbacks in this sector on priority basis, he added.

Sadique also apprised Narayan of the ongoing development projects of the ministry. He stressed maintaining effective coordination for smooth implementation of the projects.

The IMF DGM assured the Minister that Fund would always show interest for the development of Bangladesh's education sector.
