



BPTA team calls on Ershad

A delegation of Bangladesh Primary Teachers Association BPTA led by its President Prof. Abul Kalam Azad called on President Hussain Muhammad Ershad at the President's Secretariat in Dhaka on Sunday, reports BSS.
