Ershad's directive to solve varsity teachers' housing problems

The monthly regular meeting of the University Vice Chancellors was held in Dhaka on Saturday at the International Conference Centre with President Hussain Muhammad Ershad in the chair, reports BSS.

During the meeting President Ershad, who is also the Chancellor of universities, expressed satisfaction at the peaceful holding of elections to the students unions of Rajshahi University and Mymensingh Agriculture University.
