Highest priority given to education : Biswas

A 25-member delegation of principal, vice-principal, teachers and members of Managing Committee of East Chandpura Ahmadiya Senior Madrasa of Barisal Sadar called on President Abdur Rahman Biswas at Bangabhaban on Thursday, reports BSS.
